- Assist with visa enquiries, such as extensions or deadlines
- Support international students throughout their period of study
- Coordinating exchange programs with countries across the world
- Promote the university through the web sites, facebook
- Create promotional material for use in other countries

Entry Criteria:

Most jobs in the IO require A-levels or equivalent, although a degree in any discipline will be advantageous as you will have experience of university life. Degrees in Marketing, Sociology, Foreign Languages or Administration are particularly relevant to the role.

Experience of office work or other administrative roles will also be of benefit. IT skills are valued. Communication is a big part of this job, and International Officers are expected to be able to communicate clearly.
