We are pleased to share the program for the **Advanced Skills Senior course**, focused on **Security**, organized by the **University of Siena**.

Applications can be submitted until **<u>31 March 2025</u>**.

We will arrange your transportation from the center of Siena to thevenue.

Participation in the course involves an individual support fee of \notin 190,00 per day (from which **the costs for board and lodging at Certosa di Pontignano will be deducted**), in addition to a travel support fee of \notin 410,00 (\notin 470,00 if green transportation options are selected). Given the program's structure, **research grants are not provided**; however, an additional **teaching support contribution of \notin500,00 per person is offered**.

In this regard, we have organized "Roundtable" sessions during which participants may present topics of their choice related to the overall theme of the course: Security. Accordingly, we kindly request that **you select the items "Individual Support," "Travel Support," and "Teaching Support" in the "Financial Support" section of the Application Form** (https://drive.google.com/file/d/1cZK0t4leuIu9n0wdhApQ02SQY W81SMa/view) and **attach the completed Teaching Agreement** (https://drive.google.com/file/d/1prWwY5vIcH5A9alHa-neb3XkceYEXbH/view?usp=sharing), indicating **"1"** in the designated space for teaching hours. Once the documents are completed, **please send them as a draft to**

milani@unisi.it for review before final submission.

Furthermore, although the call stipulates a maximum course duration of 10 days with 6 days of activity, for organizational reasons, the activities have been concentrated into 6 consecutive days. Consequently, **up to 4 additional mobility days may be arranged before and/or after** the course. In this case, **accommodation must be booked directly by the**
